## WEEK 6 - PNEUMATOLOGY

DEFINITION OF PNEUMATOLOGY: The Doctrine/Study of the Holy Spirit

1. <u>WHO IS HE</u>? - The Holy Spirit is not just a <u>Thing</u>, a <u>Being</u> ,or a <u>Force</u> ... He is a <u>Person</u> , the 3rd person of the <u>Trinity</u>; He has special <u>characteristics</u> and <u>functions</u> that demonstrate His personality.

\* The Holy Spirit is not a <u>physical</u> being, but is a <u>Spirit</u>; He is not restricted to a <u>body</u>, but He is not personality and individuality which are demonstrated by His <u>attributes</u>.

### 2. SOME ATTRIBUTES OF THE HOLY SPIRIT:

1) <u>KNOWLEDGE</u> - 1 Cor. 2: 10 -"the Spirit searches the deep things of God" - 1 Cor. 2:13 - "the Spirit teaches us"

- 2) EMOTION -Rom. 15:30 "the love of the Spirit"
- 3) <u>A WILL</u> 1 Cor. 12:11 "as He wills"
- 4) <u>OMNIPOTENCE</u> Rom. 15:19 "the power of the Spirit"
- 5) <u>OMNISCIENCE</u> 1 Cor. 2:11 "the Spirit knows the thoughts of God"
- 6) <u>OMNIPRESENCE</u> 1 Cor. 12:4-6 one Spirit, one Lord, one God for all
- \* The Holy Spirit is God ... He is one with the Father and Son (1 John 5:7).

#### 3. HIS ROLE AND FUNCTION IN THE TRINITY:

- 1) fulfils God's will and purpose
- 2) <u>Reveals</u> Jesus Christ
- 3) <u>Draws</u> people to Jesus
- 4) <u>Convicts</u> us of sin
- 5) In-fills us with Himself [Spirit]

### 4. WHAT JESUS REVEALED ABOUT HIM: (John 14:16, 17,26)

a) He is a "Counselor" (v.16) -literally means" <u>a person summoned to one's</u> <u>aid</u> "; refers to a Friend, One who will help those who need Him, a Comforter and Defender.

b) He would be with us forever (v.16) - He took the place of <u>Jesus</u>, and is the <u>presence</u> of Christ on this earth; He <u>abides</u> with us continuously. c) He is the "Spirit of Truth" (v.17) - He is the Spirit of <u>God</u>, and God is a God of <u>truth</u>; the Holy Spirit <u>reveals</u> the truth to us and <u>applies</u> it to our lives. d) The world does not know Him (v.17) - the world's eyes are blinded by <u>sin</u>; they have no <u>knowledge</u> of the things of the Spirit, and are <u>unaware</u> of His workings.

- e) We know Him (v.17) if we know <u>Jesus</u>, we will know the Holy Spirit in our lives, and we will be able to see His work in us (becoming more like Jesus).
- f) He lives with us, and in us (v.17) not only is He our <u>Companion</u> and <u>Helper</u>, but when we come to know Jesus, He comes to <u>dwell</u> in us, and <u>lives</u>

in us (1 Cor. 6:19 - "your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God").

g) He teaches us all things (v.26) - teaches us the things of God and how to be like Jesus.

#### 5. AREAS IN WHICH THE HOLY SPIRIT WORKS:

1) <u>CREATION</u> - Gen. 1:2 - the Holy Spirit is associated with both the creation of the <u>world</u> and the <u>new creation</u> of life in a born again believer.

2) <u>THE UNSAVED</u> - He <u>convicts</u> those who are still in sin, <u>reveals</u> Jesus Christ, makes them aware of a <u>saving God</u> and the possibility of <u>change</u>; He uses <u>believers</u> and <u>God's Word</u> as a means to do this.

3) <u>THE OLD TESTAMENT</u> - He <u>touched</u> and <u>came upon</u> men of God, enabling them to carry out God's work, and giving them the <u>knowledge</u> that God was directing them.

4) <u>THE LIFE OF JESUS</u> - Jesus' <u>birth</u> was by the Holy Spirit; the Spirit drove him into the wilderness to be <u>tempted</u>; Jesus resisted the temptation in the <u>power</u> of the Spirit, and did many <u>miracles</u> and <u>mighty works</u> as He walked in the **Spirit**.

5) <u>THE CHURCH</u> - He <u>launched</u> the church on the Day of Pentecost; He <u>guided</u> the church, <u>protected</u> **it**, <u>directed</u> it, and was the <u>key</u> to the ministry of the apostles (eg. Stephen was full of the Holy Spirit, and the people could not stand up to his word or authority); He broke down <u>racial</u> **barriers** (eg. Philip ministered to the Samaritans).

6) <u>THE INDIVIDUAL</u> .. He brings spiritual <u>life</u>, He <u>indwells</u> us, He <u>assures</u> us of our salvation, He <u>sanctifies</u> (purifies) us, He <u>empowers</u> us, He assists us in our <u>worship</u>, He <u>adopts</u> us as children of God, He <u>guides</u> us, He has <u>fellowship</u> with us, He <u>anoints</u> us to minister to others, He <u>seals</u> our relationship with Jesus Christ, He <u>teaches</u> us the things of God.

\*\* The Holy Spirit removes all of our <u>excuses</u> to not live a good Christian life like God intends for us to live ... the Holy Spirit <u>enables</u> us to live it!!!
