1. We need to admit we are sinners

Bible Luke 15:7 "I tell you that in the same way there will be more rejoicing in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who do not need to repent." NIV Bible

2. We need to confess our sins willingly

Bible Romans 10:9 "That if you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved." NIV Bible

3. We need to believe Jesus died for us

Bible Romans 10:10 "For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you confess and are saved." NIV Bible

4. We need to ask Jesus into our heart and life

Bible Colossions 2:6-7 "So then, just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live in him, rooted and built up in him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and over-flowing with thankfulness." NIV Bible

Say, Lord I need you. Come into my life and heart and make me alive spiritually today, now.

How to Receive Peace & Forgiveness with God

1. Admit - personally admit to God that you want to be free from sin's death penalty
2. Confess - your sins to God asking him to forgive you for living without him
3. Believe - in your heart that God raised Jesus from the dead
4. Receive - by faith ask Jesus to come into your heart to give you God's free gift of salvation

The evidence of new life in Christ will be peace in your heart, which will follow your confession of faith. You are now alive spiritually.

We are now guaranteed Eternal Life in Heaven when we die.
