3. **Wont everyone judge me if I return to church?** NO, understand that church is the safest and most connected place to go. It is a place to grow, find support from others and learn to serve. Read **Colossians 2:6-7**. If you want to rededicate your life to God, you can do it today.

2. **Do I see the church as full of hypocrites?** If you answer yes then understand that we are all sinners saved by grace. We all fail in what we say and do including those we see in church. Focus your attention on God, not on others. God is the reason we go. Read **Romans 3:23**

1. **Am I struggling to believe God loves me?** If you answer yes then re-establish contact with God through prayer and Bible reading immediately. Ask God to renew his love in your heart. Read **Romans 8:37-39**

Ask yourself these questions

Because God is morally perfect he has the right to condemn sin. God's way of dealing with us is always fair. God provided a way to be saved from sin through Jesus death on the cross. Freedom comes from God. But if you once believed and now have turned away, here is what to do.

How to Receive Peace & Forgiveness with God

1. **Admit** - personally admit to God that you want to be free from sin's death penalty
2. **Confess** - your sins to God asking him to forgive you for living without him
3. **Believe** - in your heart that God raised Jesus from the dead
4. **Receive** - by faith ask Jesus to come into your heart to give you God's free gift of salvation

The evidence of new life in Christ will be peace in your heart, which will follow your confession of faith. You are now alive spiritually.

Lord, I admit that I need you and I confess my sin. Forgive me for living without you. I believe Jesus died on the cross for my sin. Cleanse me now. I ask you to come into my heart and life. Be my Saviour from this day forward until you call me home. Amen
